WORSHIP CHANGES ARE COMING

Now that Concordia has successfully created and maintained a safe environment for in-person worship, additional changes will be introduced to enhance our worship experience as we move into the Fall season.

Starting on Saturday, October 3rd, Walk-Up communion administered by Pastor Gregg and the Elders will be offered as an option. This is the same method used at Christmas and Easter services and will be familiar to most of you attending worship. Individual Fellowship Kits will still be available for those who prefer to remain in their seat during communion.

Starting on Sunday, November 1st, the Traditional service will be moving to Sunday morning. Traditional and Contemporary worship services will be offered each Sunday thereafter. No services will be conducted on Saturday.

Additionally, signups will no longer be required prior to attending the service of your choice.

As we implement these changes, please be aware that the safety protocols – wearing of masks, social distancing, positive airflow, hand sanitizer, surface cleaning – that have served us well to date will remain in place. We look forward to taking these next steps and pray your worship experience will be enhanced.

We are coming together for the mutual edification of our brothers and sisters. We are thankful that we have the technology to keep us connected even when we are apart, yet there is a great blessing when believers can come together in person to worship Jesus. We are thankful and excited as we begin to re-open. Please be patient as we seek to navigate through these times and praise the Lord as He continues to work for His glory and for the salvation of all people!

As we reopen, we will continue to record and make weekly sermons and services available online. Pastor Gregg's sermons will be available online Sunday morning and services will be available online early in the week following weekend worship.
